Meeting formally commenced with the recitation from the Holy Quran.

Agenda items of the meeting were as follows:

1. Review of previous meeting, the decision taken & status of implementation.
2. Disposal of old / target cases.
3. Consignment of record.
4. Any other matter, with permission of the Chair.

1. REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MINUTES OF MEETING

The minutes of previous meeting held on 21.09.2016 and the proposed actions taken thereupon were reviewed thoroughly and found satisfactory to great extent.

2. DISPOSAL OF OLD/ TARGET CASES

Disposal of old / target cases was discussed at length. The participants furnished the data of old/target cases. It appears from the data so furnished, that 26 old cases of Land Acquisition are pending in the court of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge-I, Nowshera which needs disposal.

Due to long leave obtained by Presiding Officer Mrs. Imrana Shaheen, Civil Judge-VI, learned District & Sessions Judge, Nowshera felt the need of distribution of target cases. So the old /target civil suits pending before the said court were transferred to the other civil courts of competent jurisdiction vide order No.1889-1904-4/8 dated 27.09.2016 of the hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Nowshera, in order to avoid delay in disposal of old/ target cases; the detail whereof is tabulated as before:

The Chair once again stressed upon the participants to speed up and to accelerate the disposal of old/ target cases. That proper attention be also given to the disposal of newly instituted cases to achieve best results in DPEP. The Chair also directed the participants to avoid un-necessary adjournments in the cases. The participants explained that slow disposal of the cases is due to the engagement of some senior lawyers at upper forum. So, the Chair reminded the participants about the diary lock concept of the senior and busy lawyers to achieve the target.

3. CONSIGNMENT OF RECORD

Consignment of record also came under discussion. The Chair emphasized upon timely consignment of cases to the record room. All the judicial officers also ensured about timely consignment of the disposed of cases to record room by the moharrirs of their courts.

4. PUNCTUALITY

The Chair expressed his satisfaction regarding the punctuality observed by the judicial officers presently. The Chair directed the participants that attendance of ministerial staff be also checked properly and regularly.

5. EQUALIZATION OF PENDENCY

The participants showed their satisfaction upon the present scheme of distribution of cases.

6. ANY OTHER MATTER

The Chair also discussed with the participants about the problem in criminal cases, that usually these cases are adjourned due to non-availability of case property and directed the judicial officers to requisition the same properly mentioning in the order sheets directing SHO concerned to produce the case property in evidence so as to avoid unnecessary adjournments.

It was unanimously agreed during the current meeting that prosecution and judicial collaboration is needed in order to maintain exact and accurate data of the challan and cases put in court after investigation for avoiding delay of submission of challans in order to meet the stipulated time as provided in the Criminal Procedure Code.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
