<b>(Item # 3)</b> Record of cases	Submission of record by Police in bail cases have since been improved still there is a room for further improvement. SP Investigation informed the Chair that parties are in the habit of submitting applications regarding their innocence to the High ups instead of investigation officer to pave way for parallel enquiry which is against the legal spirit. Judicial officers sometimes insists on the production of such enquiry reports.	The Chair asserted that requisitioning of such type of enquiries unless made the part of investigation are undesirable and amounts to interference with the process of investigation. <b>(Item # 5)</b> Mines & Minerals	Assistant Director Mines brought into the notice of the house that courts sometimes issue stay orders on the disputed agreements or leases and the Lessee taking advantage of the stay order keep on excavating the mineral unlawfully even after expiry of their lease. <b>(Item # 6)</b> Price Magistrates	The Chair expressed its concern over the non-submission of reports by the price checking Magistrates empowered to deal with iron hands against the black marketers, hoarders and unhygienic food item sellers causing common diseases in the general public. The Chair cautioned the price Magistracy about his surprise visits to their offices & field operations. In most of these petty cases fall under the ambit of cognizable offences and judgment copies must be provided to the prosecution for onward entry into register 1 part 2. Prosecution must depute its representatives to achieve the required results and streamlining of the record.
